Temporary Local Rules

Preferred Lies in the GENERAL AREA. The General area covers the whole course except for specific areas as defined under rule 2.2. It does not cover the Teeing area, Penalty areas, All Bunkers, Putting Green or trees.

How to take relief: Mark, lift, clean and place your ball within Twelve inches or you can also use the length of the scorecard as a measurement, no closer to the hole. Always let your fellow players know what you plan to do and get their agreement before taking relief.

- 1. Holes 1,5,6 and 7 North The ball is in classified as ground under repair, when in "The Wash". You may either play your ball as it lies. or take free relief. To take relief, use the crest of the ditch as your marking point then take one club length no nearer the hole. Always let your fellow players know what you plan to do and get their agreement before taking relief.
- 2. Large bare patches Example North 6. Mark, lift, clean and place your ball within 12" of the nearest point of relief no closer to the hole. Always let your fellow players know what you plan to do and get their agreement before taking relief.

Note: the ditch on South 1 and North 9 are penalty areas. If your ball goes into the ditch it is considered a red staked area and one stroke penalty will apply.
